Figure 2: 2003 HIV Clients by Age Group (N = 3851)

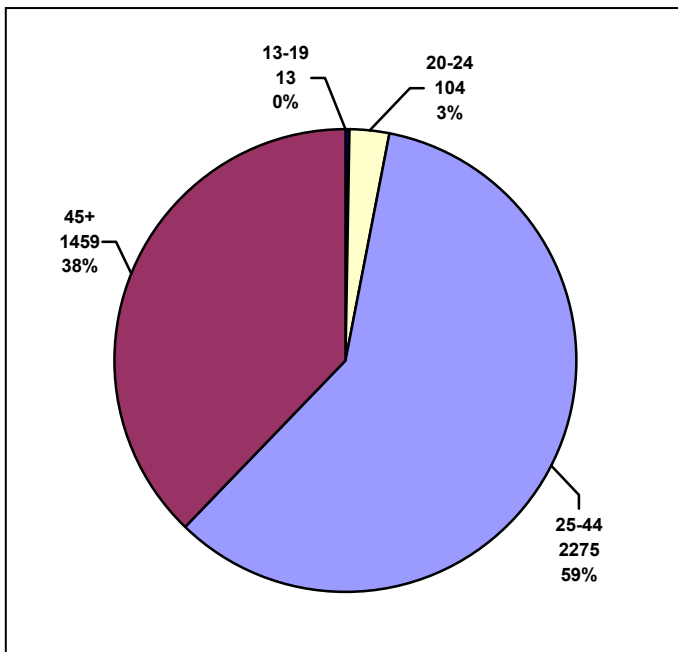


Figure 3: 2003 HIV Clients by Race/Ethnicity (N = 3851)

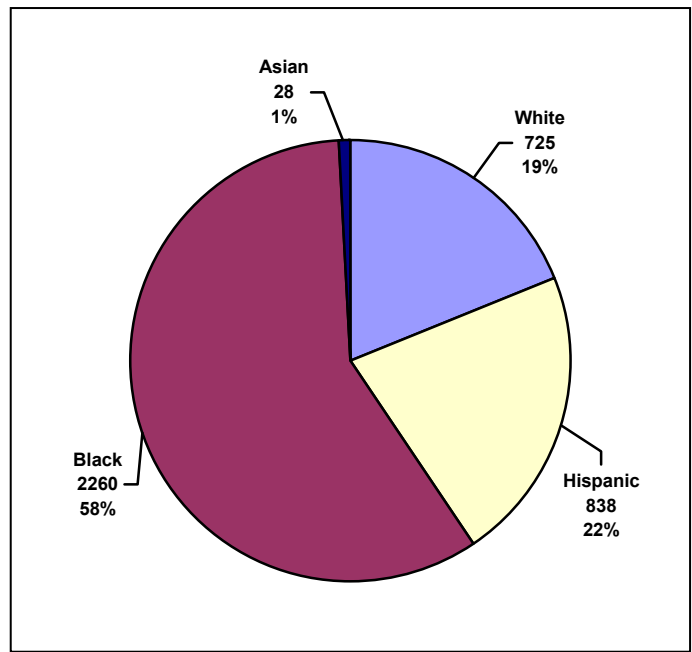

Figure 3: 2003 HIV Clients by Risk Factor (N = 3851)

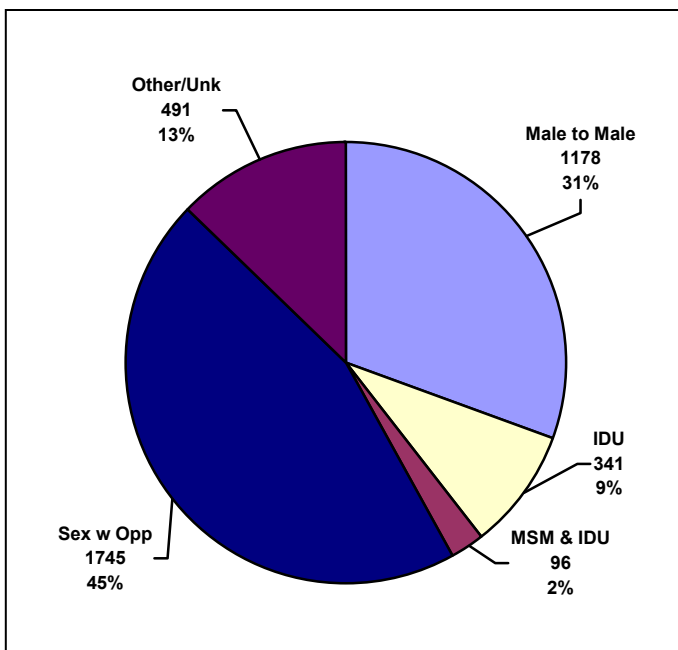

Figure 4: 2003 HIV Clients by Known Place of HIV Diagnosis (n = 2754)

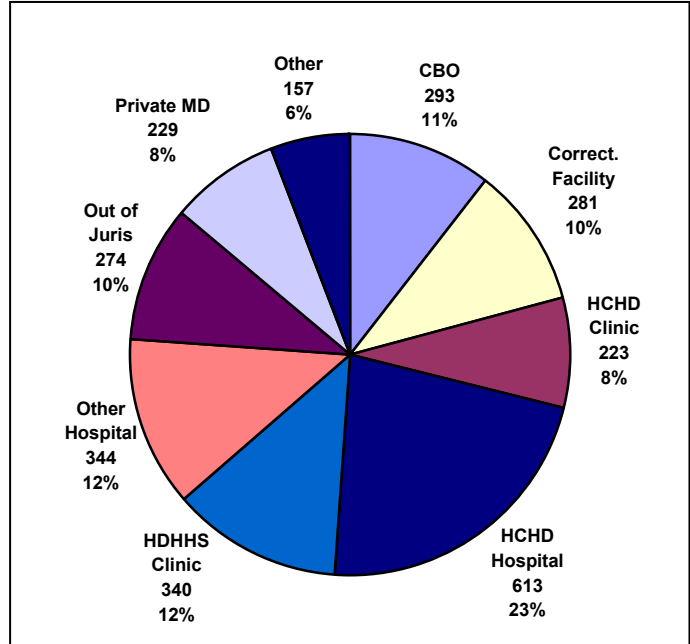
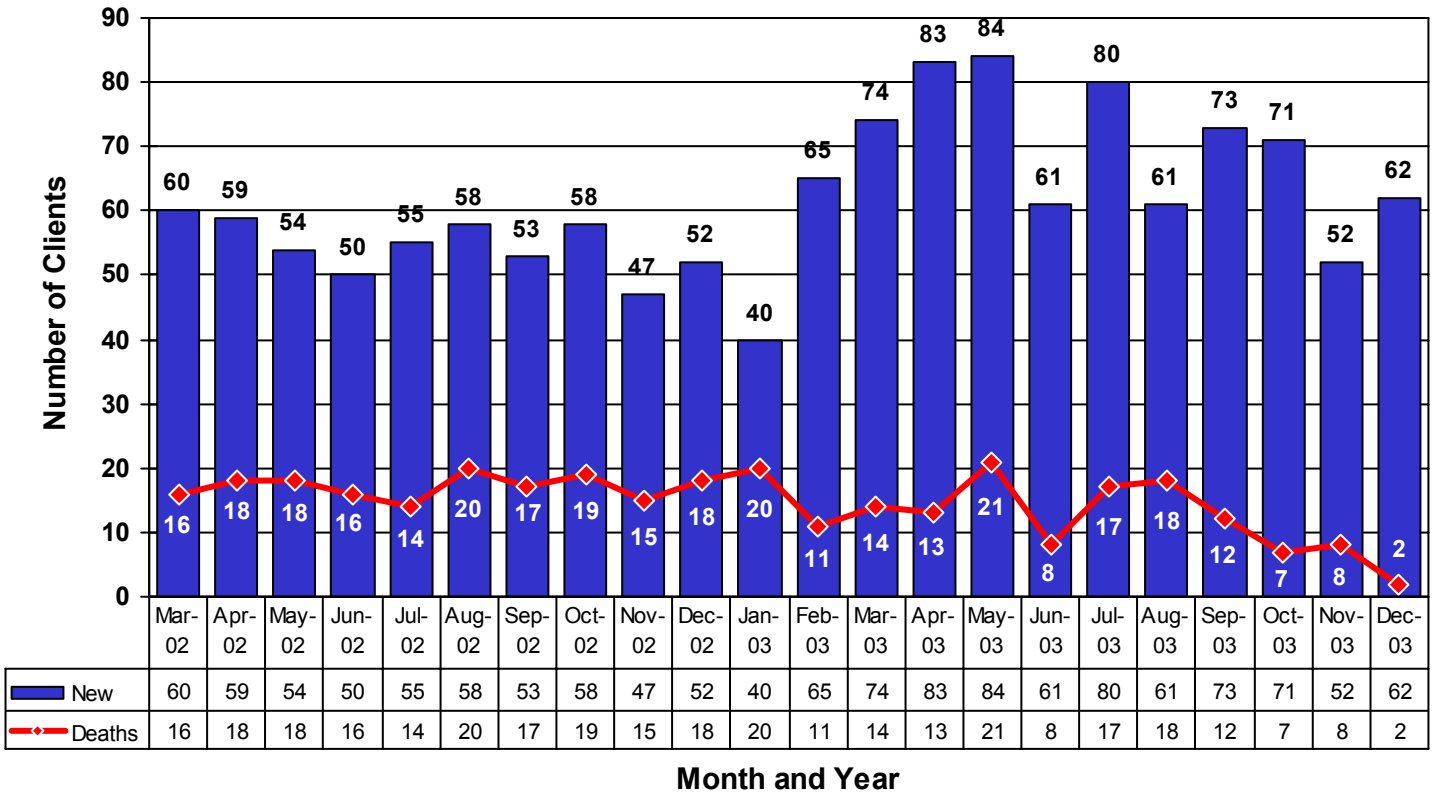


Figure 5: Deaths among HIV Clients Compared to New HIV Clients (03/2002 to 12/2003)
