Figure 1: 2007 HIV Clients by Age Group (N = 4395)

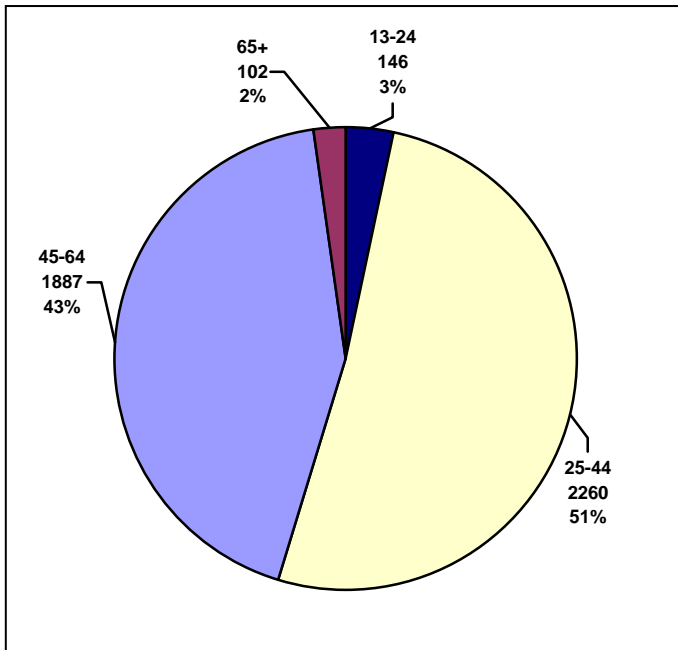


Figure 2: 2007 HIV Clients by Race/Ethnicity (N = 4389)

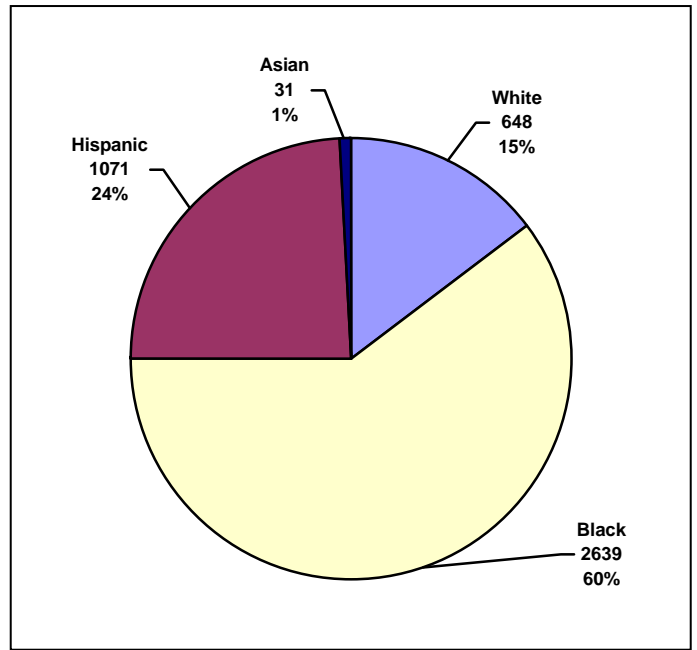

Figure 3: 2007 HIV Clients by Risk Factor (N = 4389)

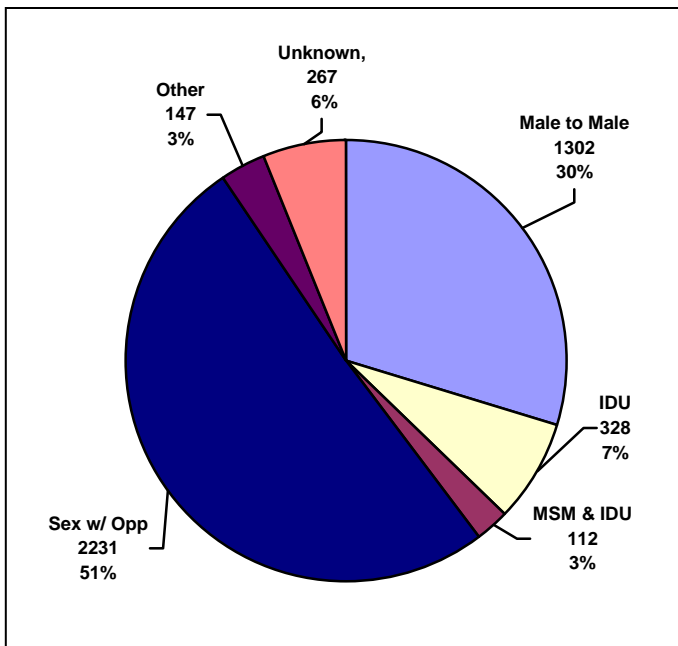

Figure 4: 2007 HIV Clients by Known Place of HIV Diagnosis (n =3754)

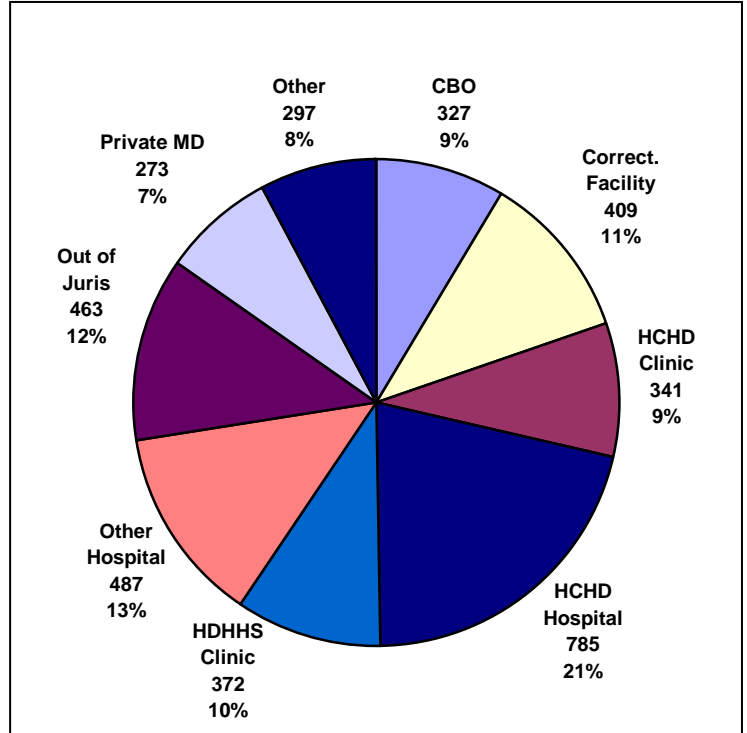
