HCHD Dedicates Remodeled Ben Taub Pediatric Emergency Center

The Harris County Hospital District's Ben Taub General Hospital will dedicate its remodeled pediatric emergency center on July 1. The area includes colorful and educational additions to the waiting and exam rooms.

The year-long remodeling project makes the center more child and family friendly. Some additions include art from patients and area students, a reading area and educational games.

The Harris County Hospital District is the fourth largest metropolitan healthcare system in the nation. It comprises three hospitals – Ben Taub General Hospital, Lyndon B. Johnson General Hospital and Quentin Mease Community Hospital – 13 satellite clinics at homeless shelters, 11 neighborhood health centers, an HIV/AIDS clinic, a dental center, six school-based clinics and five mobile health units.
