Hospital District Partners to Host Free Community Health Fair

HOUSTON (Aug. 4, 2006) – The Harris County Hospital District’s E. A. “Squatty” Lyons Community Health Center and St. Mary Magdalene Catholic Church have partnered to host a free community health fair Aug. 26. The event is open to the public and will offer residents one-stop convenience for health screenings and immunizations.

Hospital district staff will provide screenings for a variety of health concerns, including blood pressure, blood glucose, cholesterol, and vision.

Health care professionals and vendors will be on hand to discuss exercise, heart health, stroke prevention, women’s health, and nutrition. Information will be shared on exercise, weight-loss plans, smoking cessation, breast cancer, HIV/AIDS, and more.
